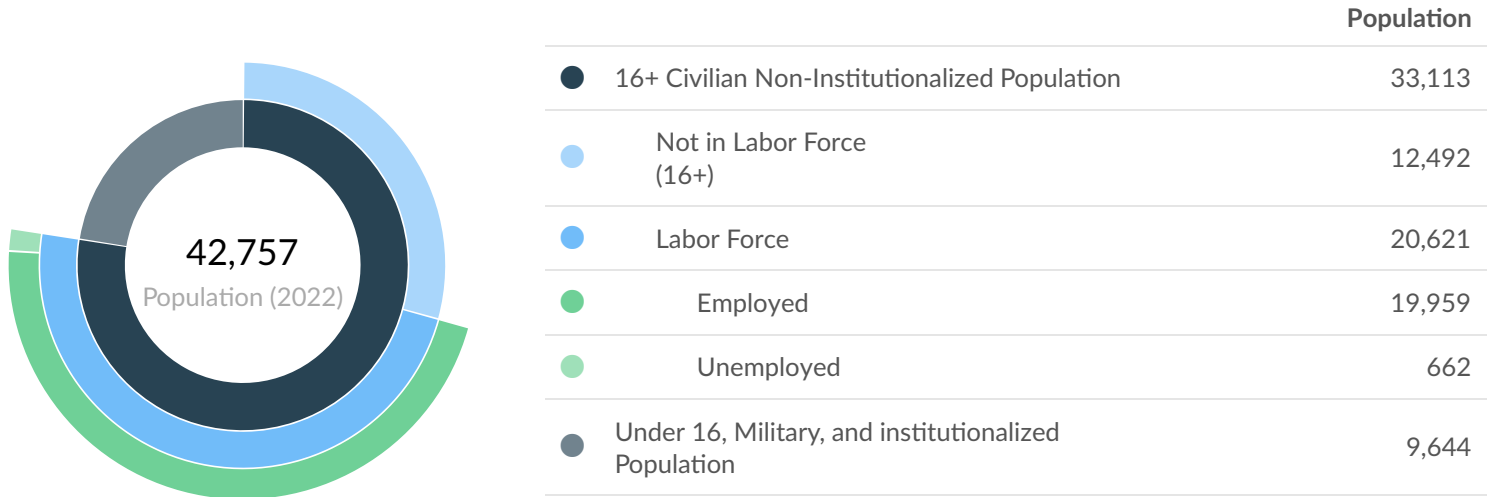
Median household income is **\$4.6K below** the national median household income of \$65.0K.

- As of 2022 the region's population **declined by 0.2%** since 2017, falling by 68. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.1%** between 2022 and 2027, losing 30.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs **declined by 6.0%** in Muscatine County, IA from 24,963 to **23,468**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 2.4% by 8.4%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 66.0% to 62.3% between 2017 and 2022**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **16.3% of Muscatine County, IA residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (4.5% below the national average), and **12.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.5% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Office Furniture (including Fixtures) Manufacturing, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Employment Services.

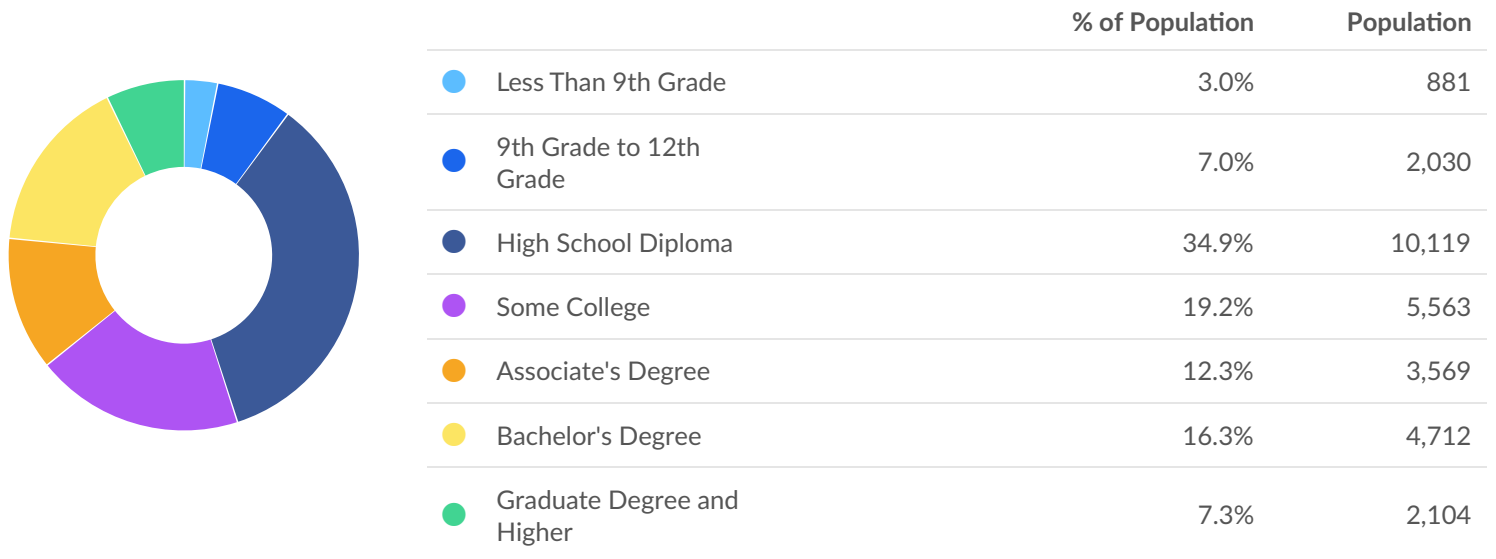

Nov 2022 Labor Force Breakdown



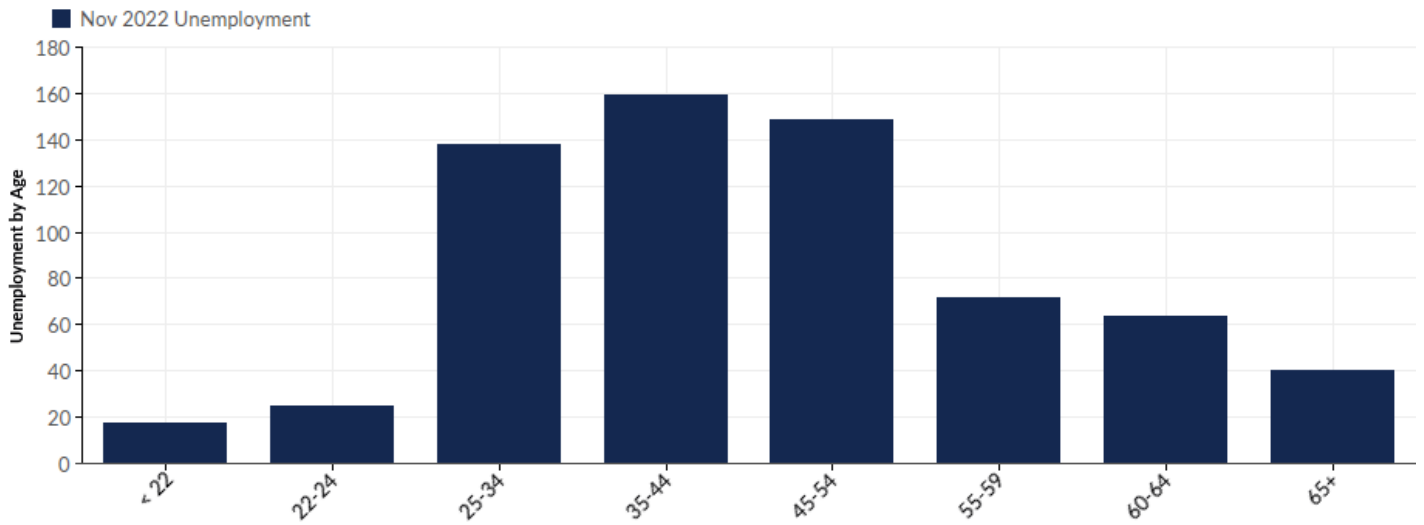
Educational Attainment

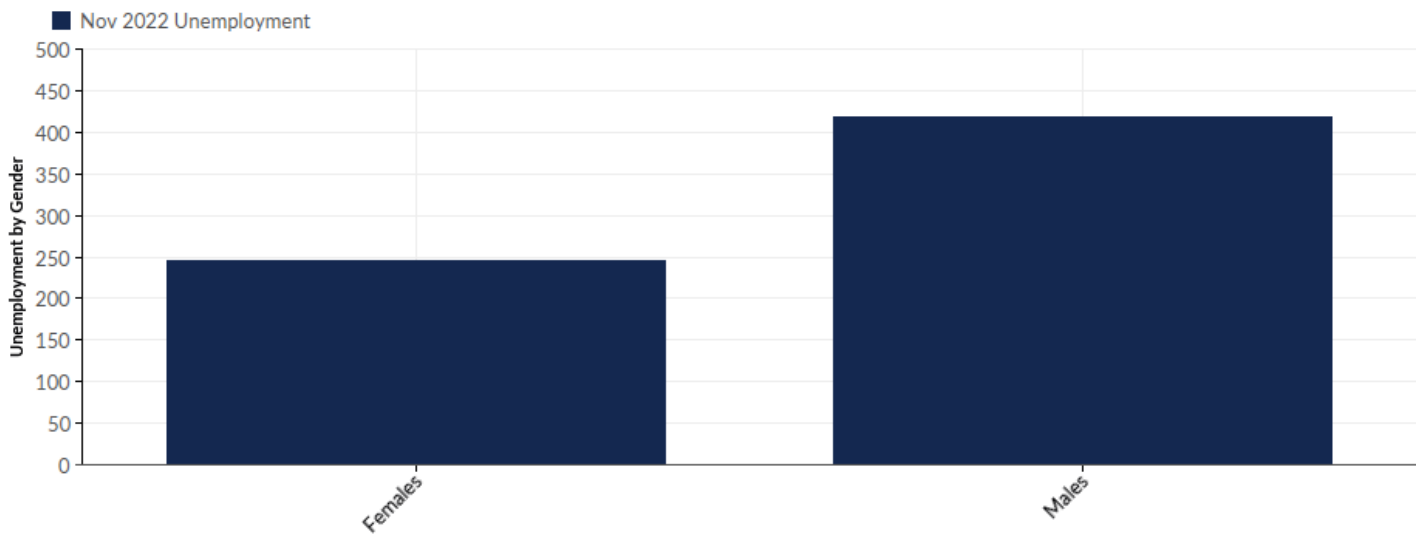

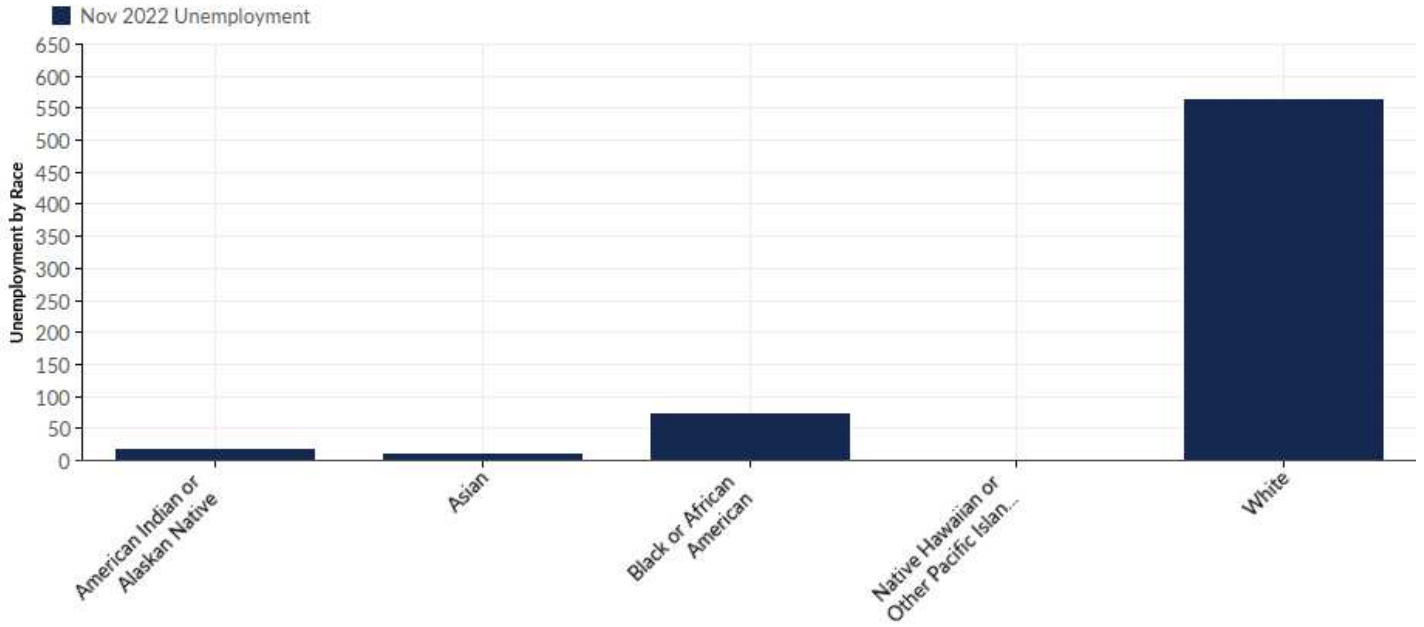

Unemployment by Gender



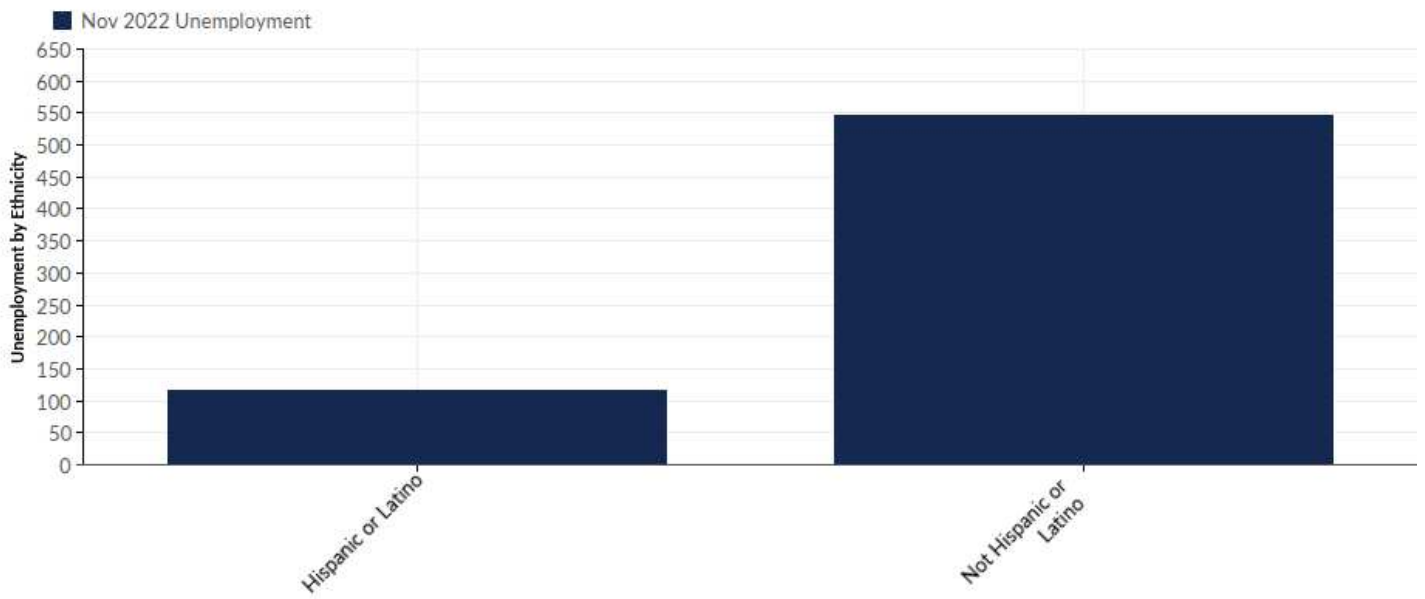

Unemployment by Ethnicity

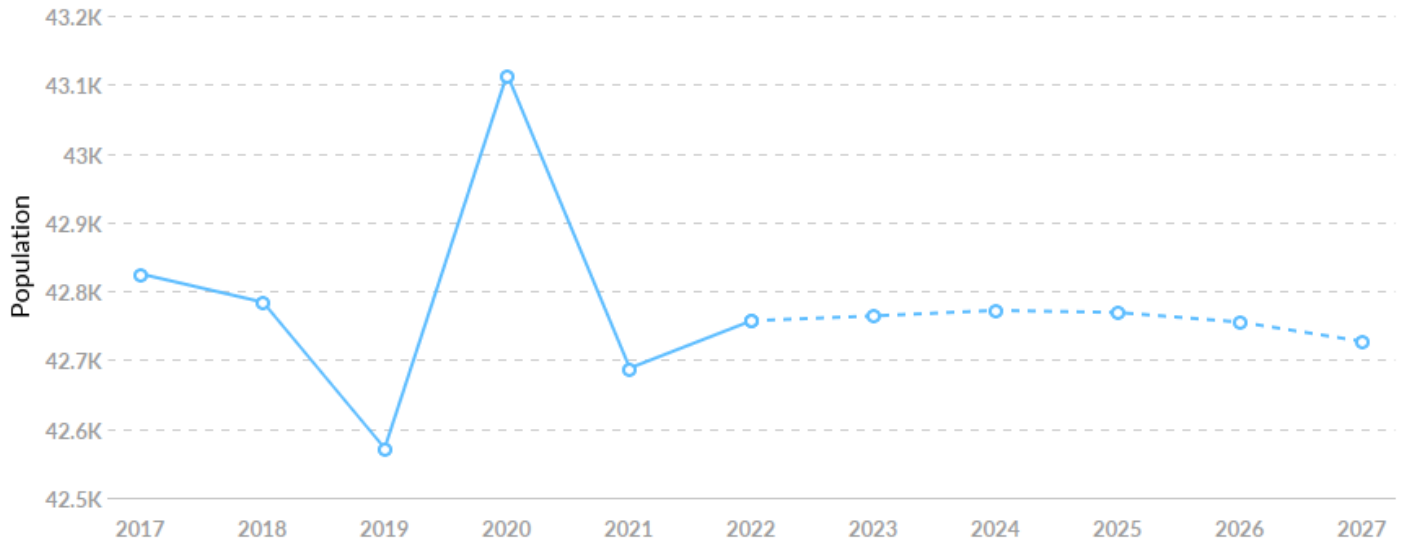

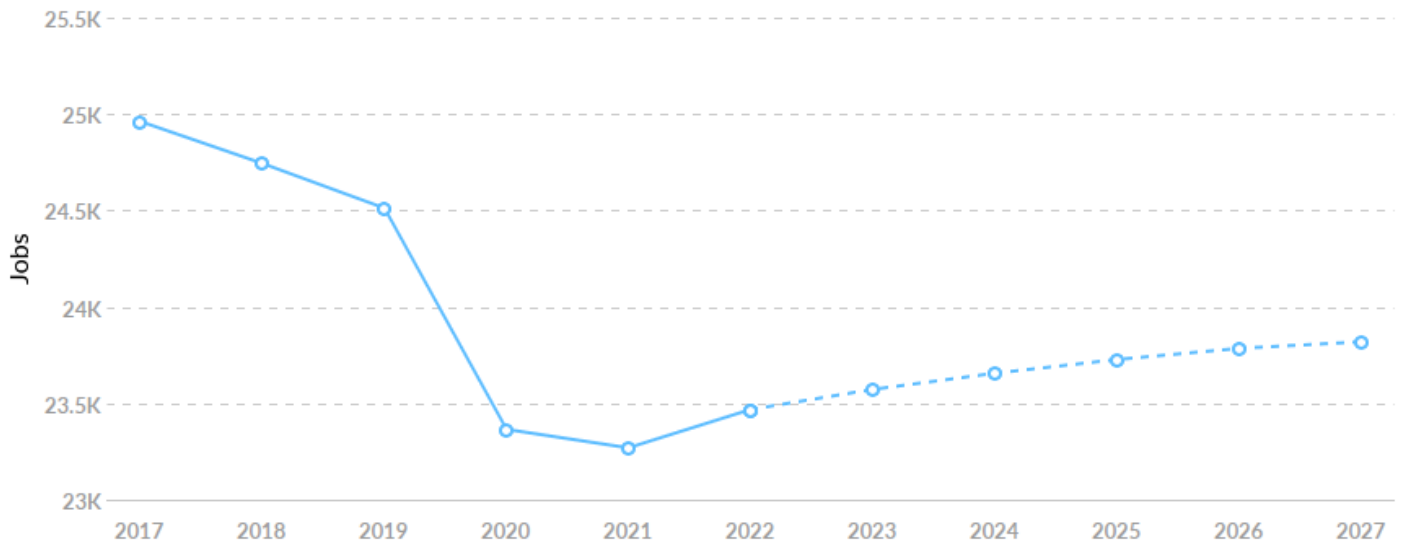

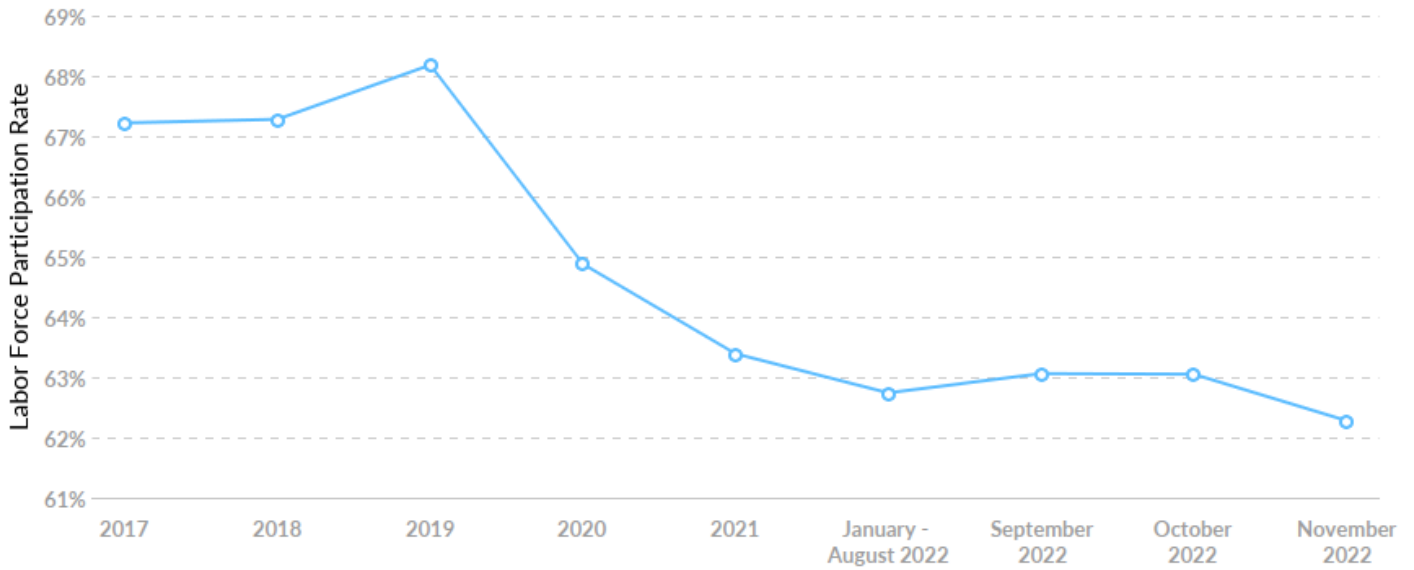
Job Trends

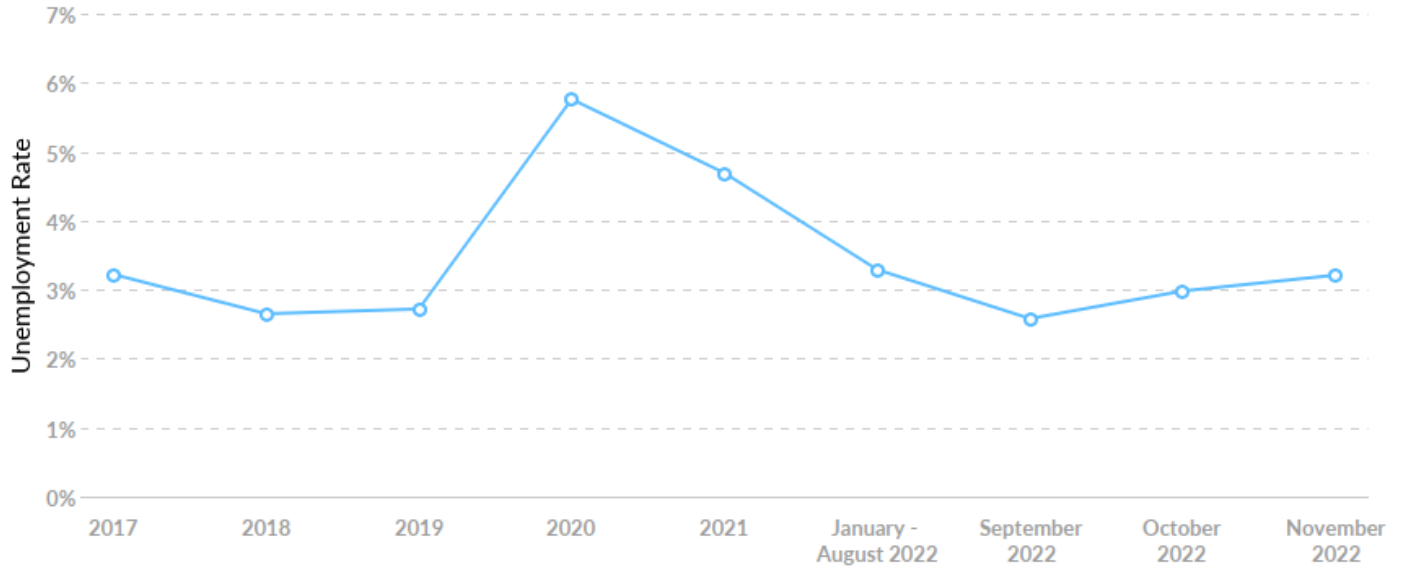

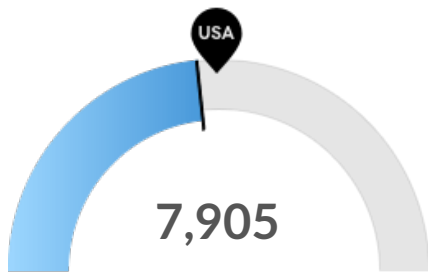
Unemployment Rate Trends

Muscatine County, IA had a November 2022 unemployment rate of 3.21%, **decreasing from 3.22%** 5 years before.



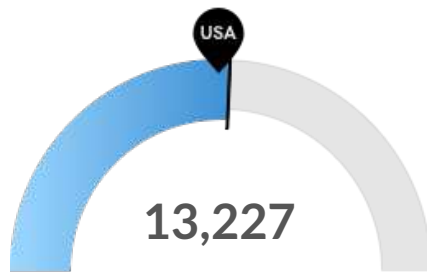

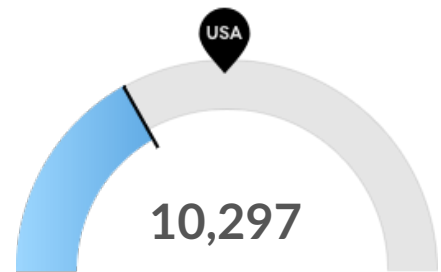
Millennials

Muscatine County, IA has 7,905 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 8,720.



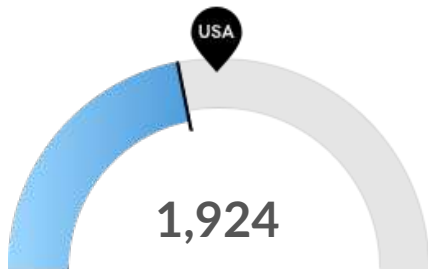
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Muscatine County, IA. The national average for an area this size is 12,688 people 55 or older, while there are 13,227 here.



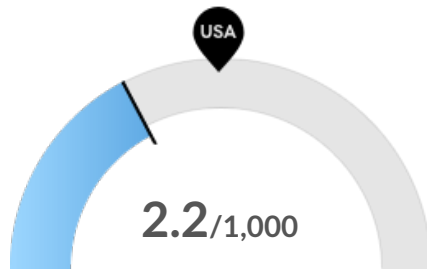
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Muscatine County, IA. The national average for an area this size is 17,371 racially diverse people, while there are 10,297 here.



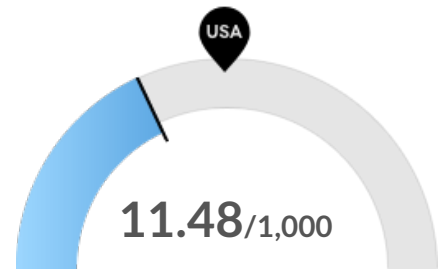
Veterans

Muscatine County, IA has 2.2 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.

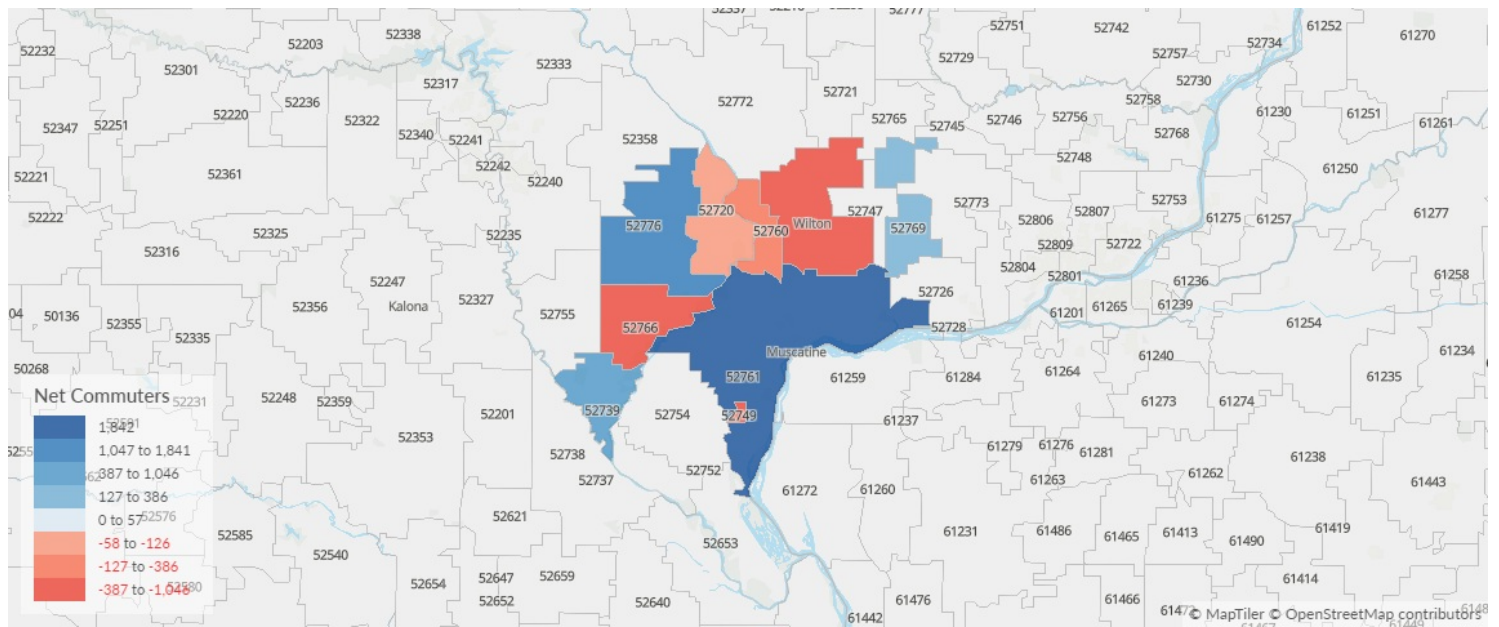


Property Crime

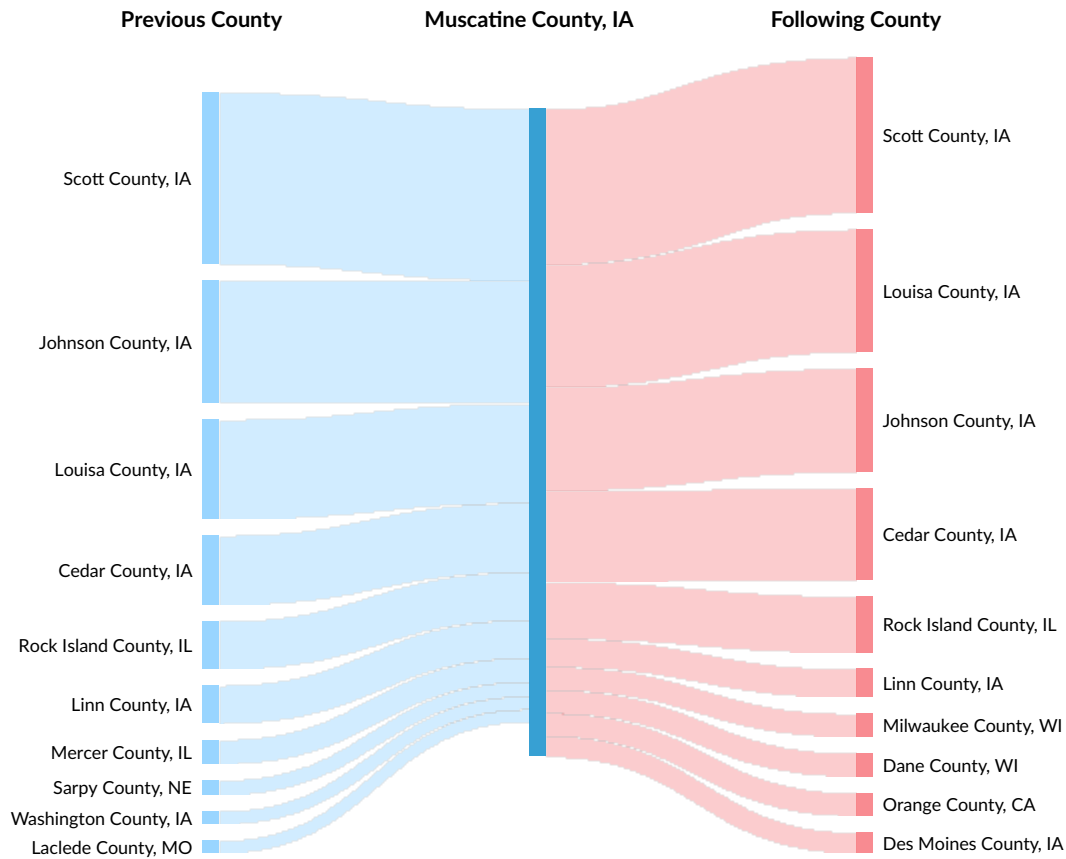

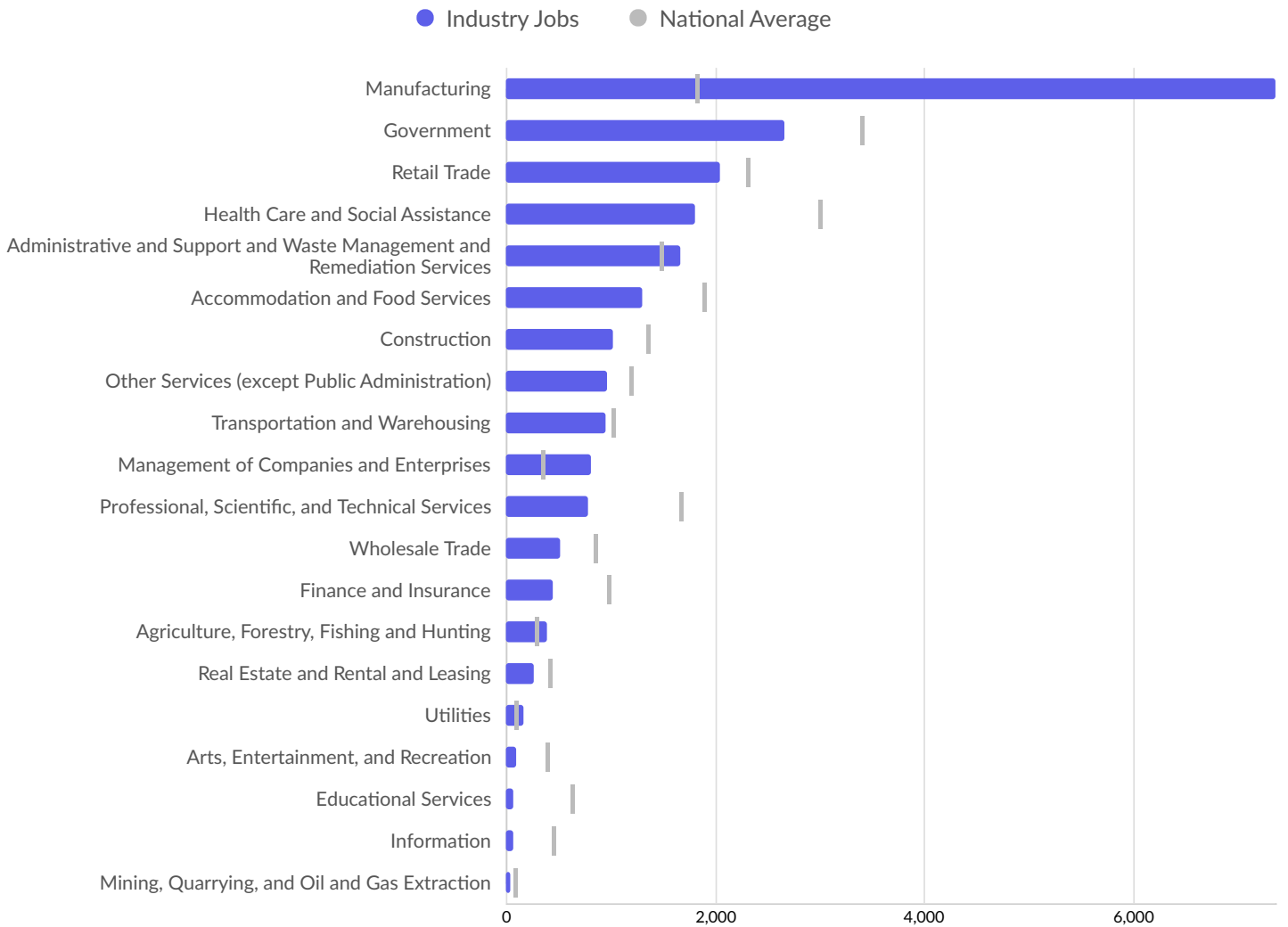

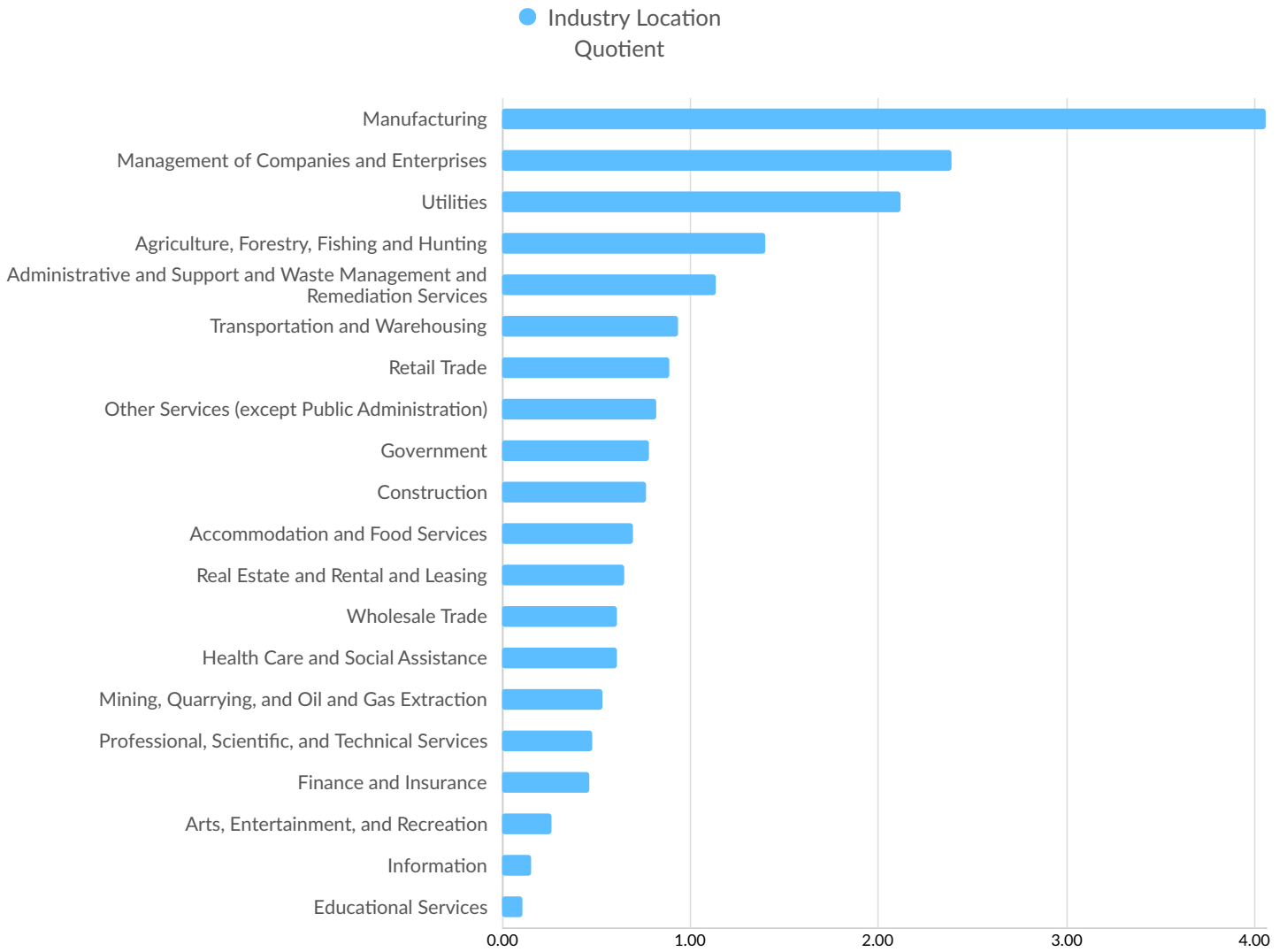

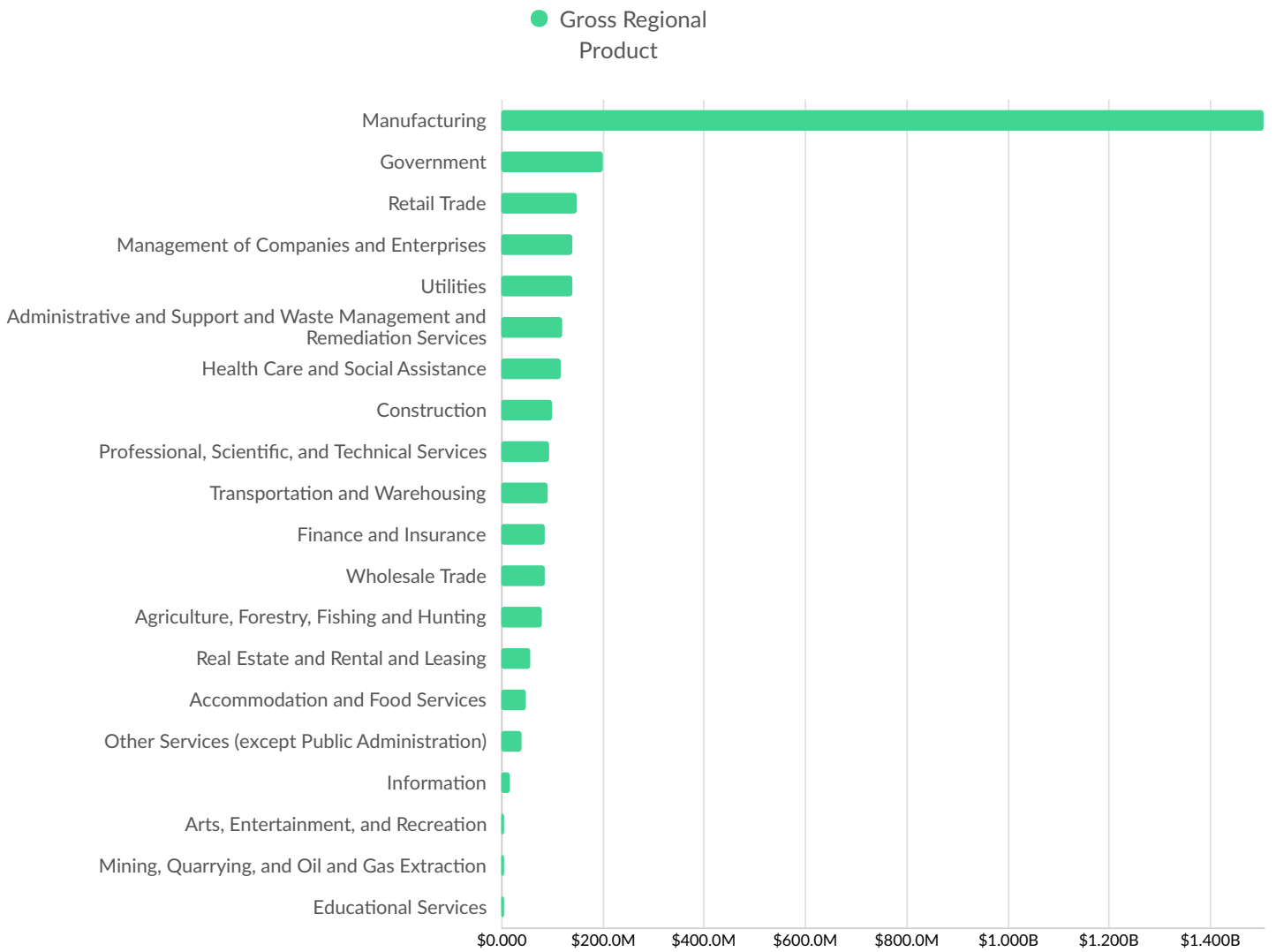
Top Growing Industries



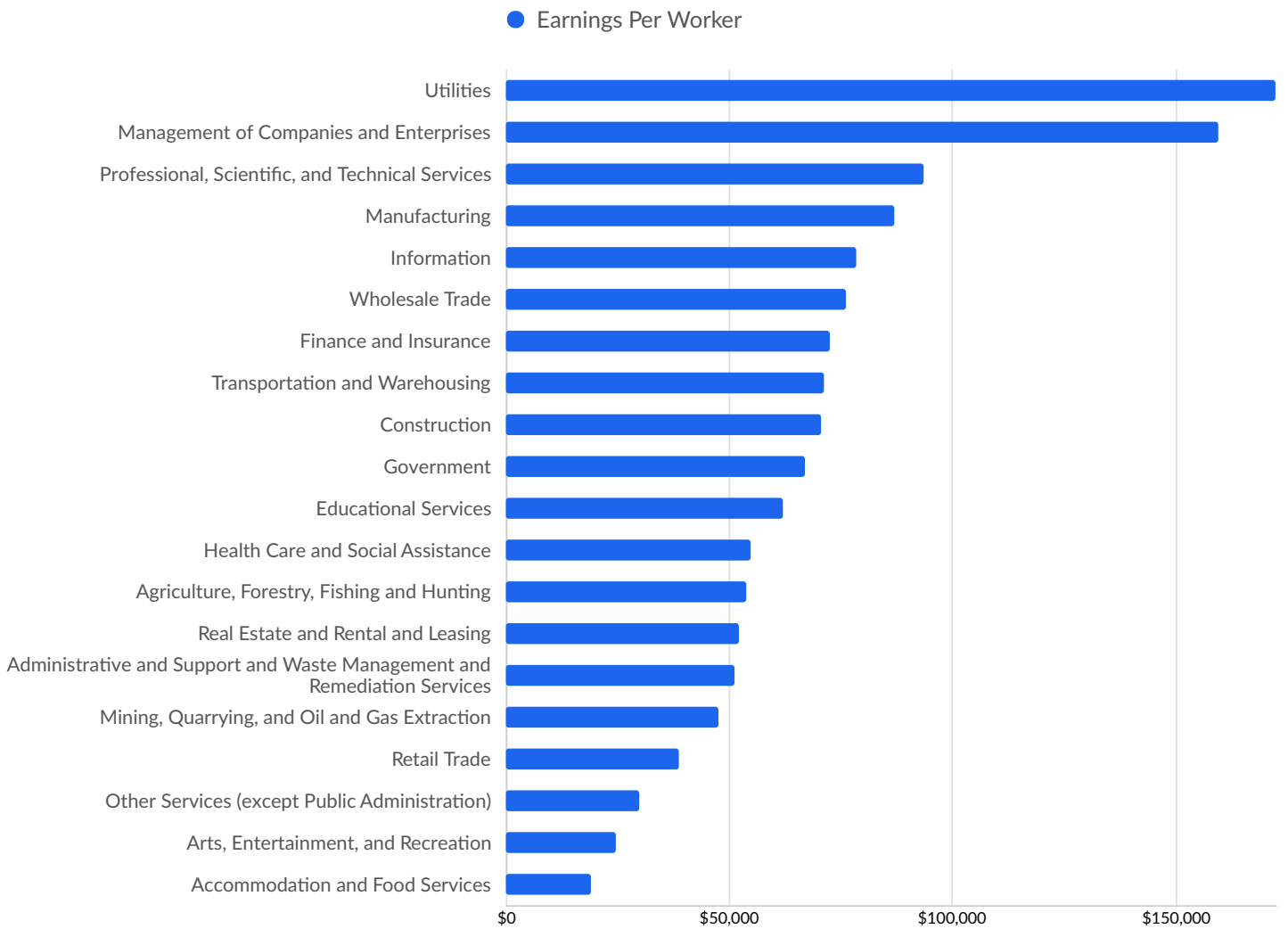
Top Industry Location Quotient

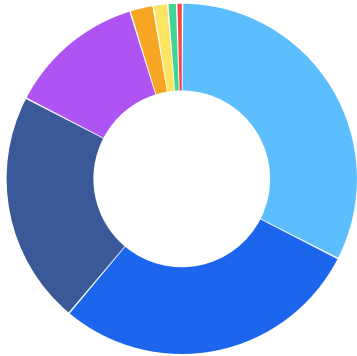

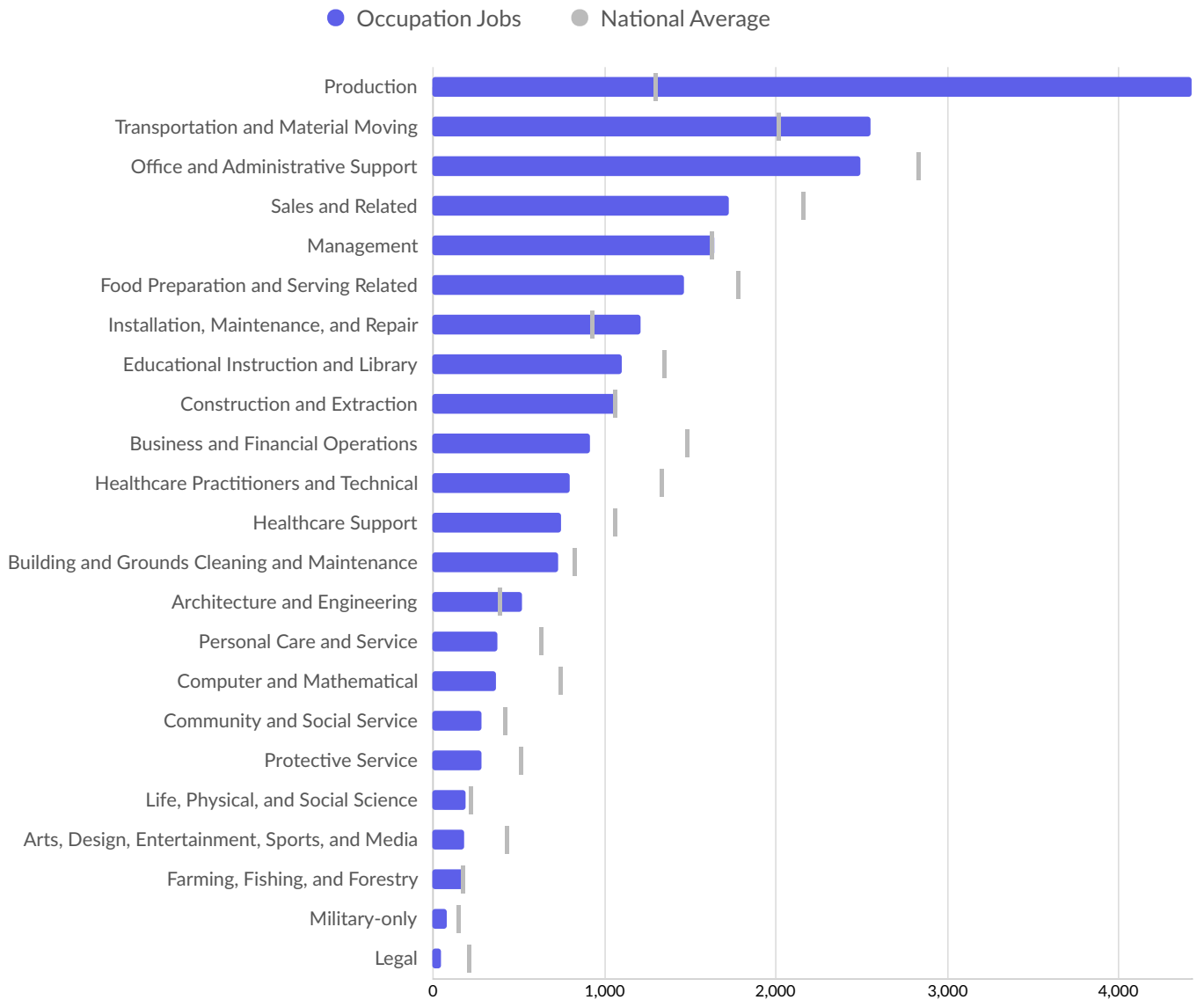

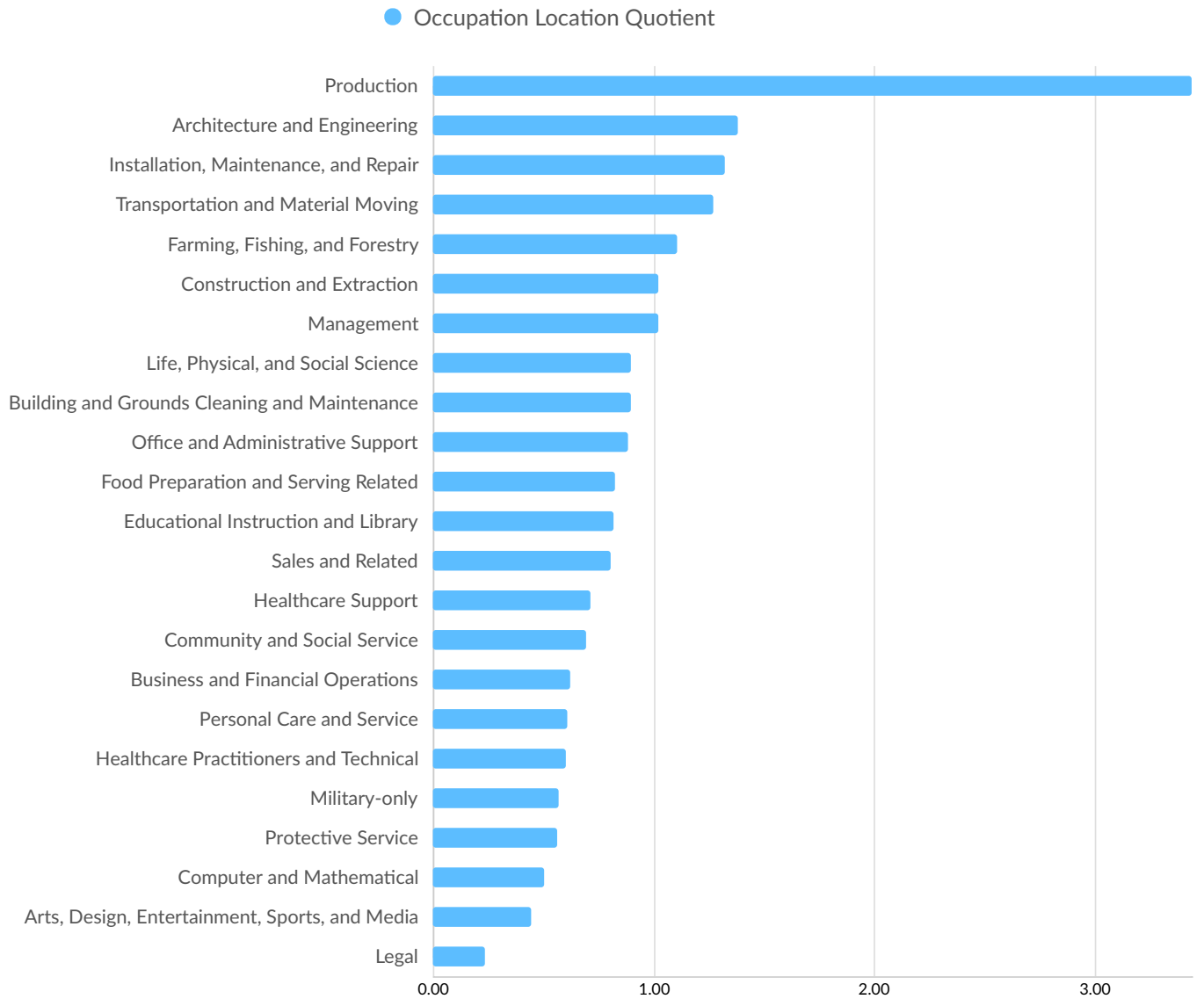
Largest Occupations



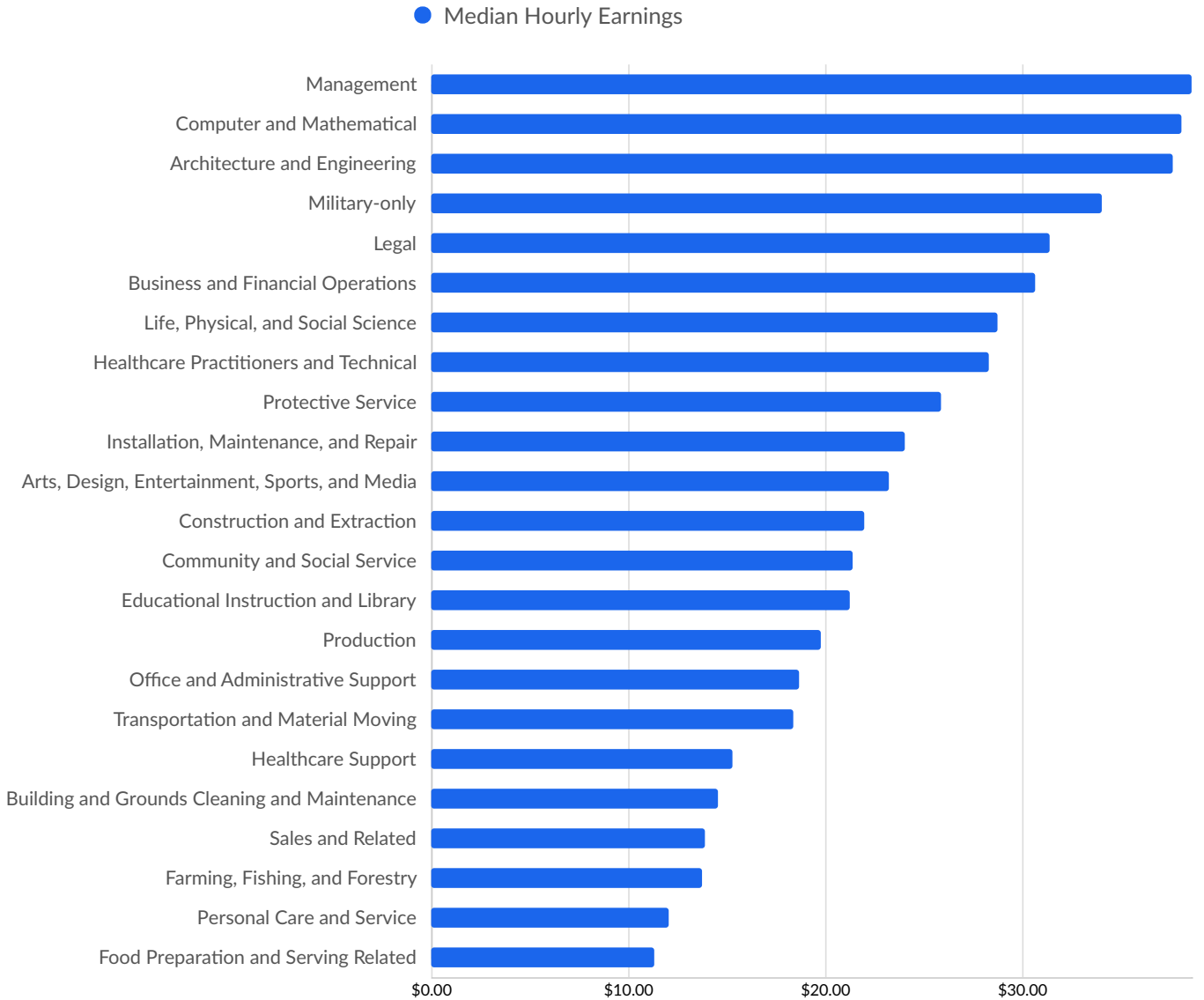
Top Growing Occupations



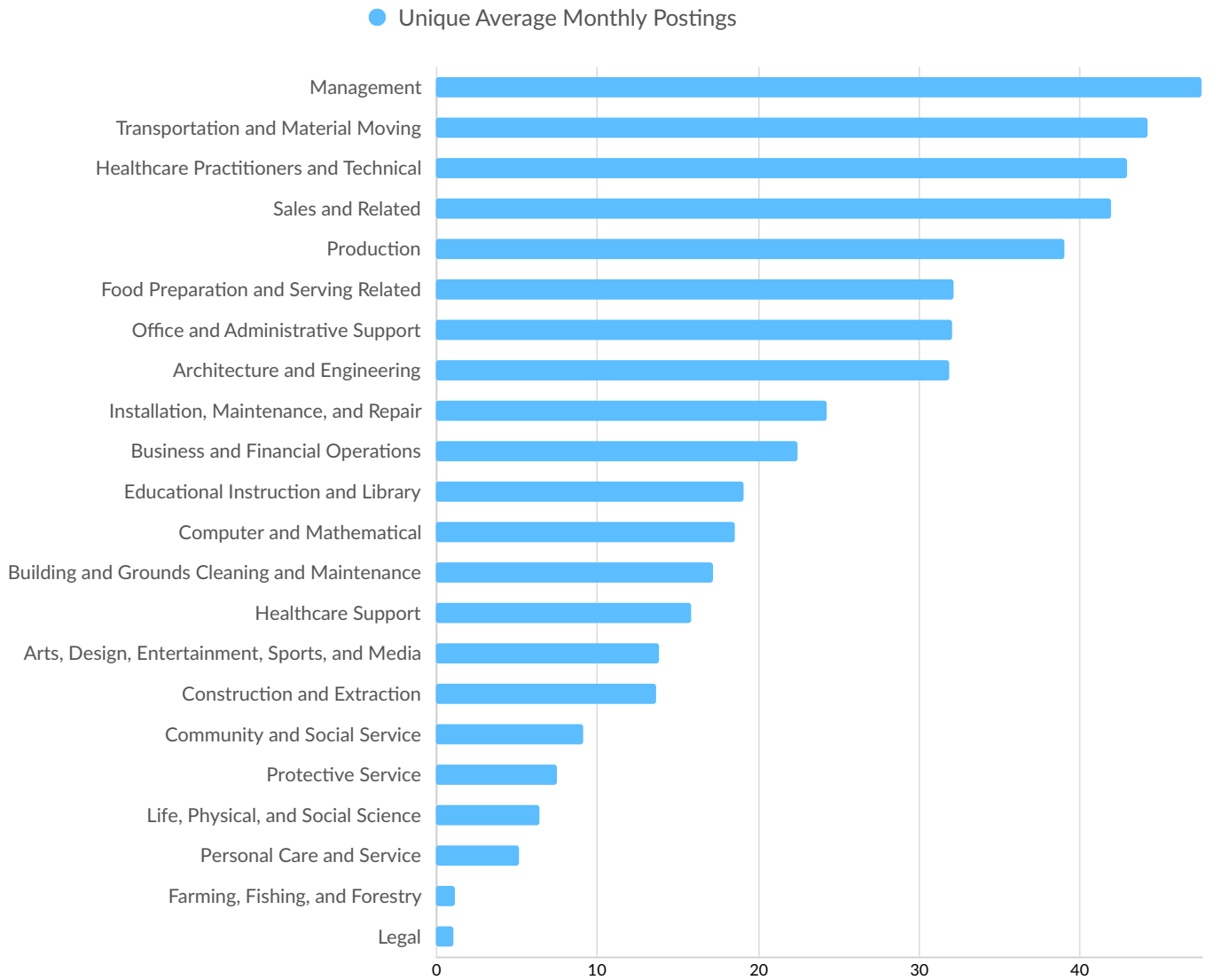
Top Occupation Location Quotient



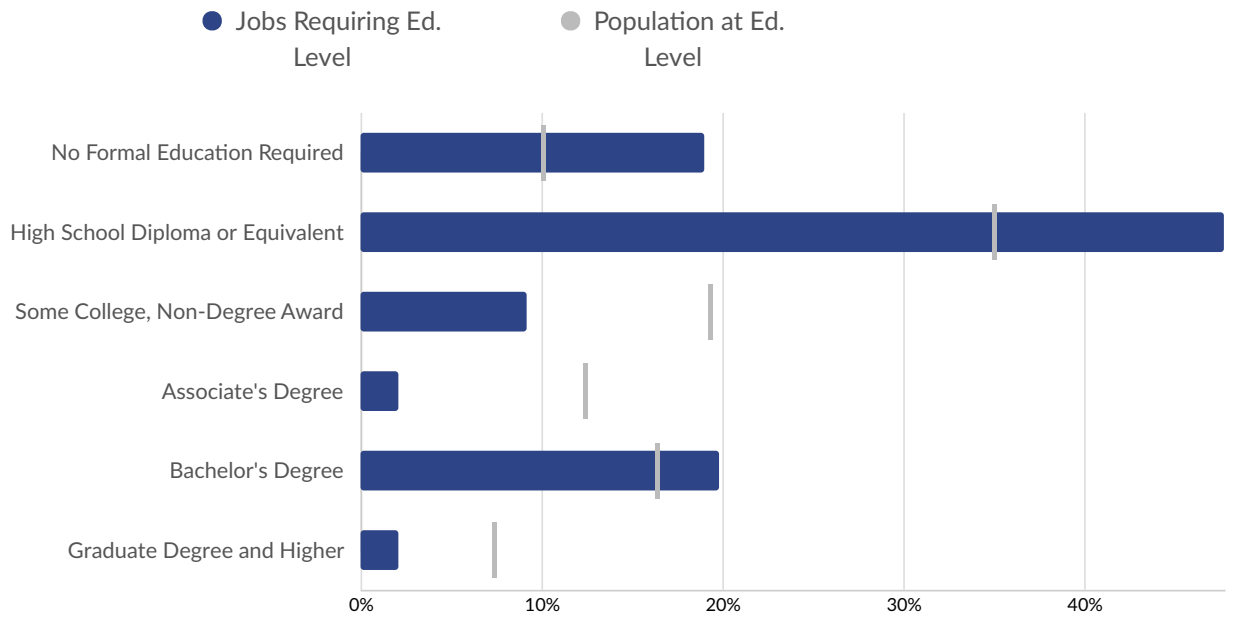
